As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance

1 Peter 1:14

Philippians 4:6 says, “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.” Now you are a Christian every decision you make needs to be considered with much prayer. You must consult God and ask for His clear direction before you make a decision. Acting against the Word of God is neither safe nor wise.

In Colossians 1:9 Paul writes, “For this reason also, since the day we heard of it, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding.” To know God, you must have a change of mind.

One way of doing this is by reading and meditating on the Bible daily. It is a good idea to set apart 30 to 60 minutes a day for reading, studying, prayer, and devotion of the Bible. Find out the best time of day when you are free and able to relax with your Bible. Most people prefer the mornings, before the busy day begins, others like me find the evenings are the most appropriate time.

Not to love the world means the world's system which is governed by the evil forces of the Devil and his demons. To do God's will you need to change the way you think. Before your salvation you did not love the things of God, but now you are a child of God you have the Holy Spirit. The in dwelt Spirit will convict you of sin, righteousness and judgement. As you grow in the grace of God you will start to love that which God loves and begin to hate that which God hates, namely your own sin.

When God is in control of your life, He will show you the right way to live. You must trust in God and conform to His way and not your way (Isaiah 55:8). The Word of God will be your path to holiness and the reading of His Word will be the light for your path (Psalm 119:105 and 2 Timothy 3:16). You must submit yourself to the authority of God and Scripture in order to follow Him, otherwise the Devil will take a foothold (James 4:7 and 1 Peter 5:8).
