The Word (Logos)	John 1:1, 14	God’s ultimate self-expression	Jesus is the communication of God Himself, Creator made flesh.	Creator, Son of God
I AM	John 8:58; Exodus 3:14	God’s eternal self-existence	Jesus identifies Himself with Yahweh—eternal and uncreated.	Yahweh, Lord
Lamb of God	John 1:29; Revelation 5:12	Sacrificial substitute for sin	The perfect, spotless sacrifice who takes away sin once for all.	Passover Lamb, Redeemer
Saviour	Luke 2:11; Titus 2:13	One who rescues	He saves not only from danger but from sin, death, and wrath.	Deliverer, Redeemer
Lord	Romans 10:9; Philippians 2:11	Sovereign master, supreme authority	Confessing Him as Lord is essential to salvation—He rules all.	King of Kings, I AM
King of Kings	Revelation 19:16; 1 Timothy 6:15	Supreme ruler over all kings	He has ultimate dominion over all earthly and spiritual powers.	Lord, Messiah
Prince of Peace	Isaiah 9:6	One who brings reconciliation and peace	Peace with God, inner peace, and future global peace through His reign.	Counsellor, Messiah, King

Second Adam	Romans 5:14; 1 Corinthians 15:45	The new head of redeemed humanity	Where Adam failed, Jesus succeeded—bringing life, not death.	Son of Man, Mediator

Ransom for Many	Mark 10:45	Payment to set captives free	Salvation was costly—His life was the price.	Saviour, Lamb
Immanuel	Matthew 1:23; Isaiah 7:14	“God with us”	God dwelling among humanity in Christ; intimate presence.	Son of God, Word
Holy One of God	Mark 1:24; Luke 4:34	Absolutely pure and set apart	Even demons recognised His holiness and divine identity.	Son of God
The Rock	1 Corinthians 10:4; Psalm 18:2	Firm foundation, refuge	Christ is the spiritual source and stability of His people.	Cornerstone
Cornerstone	Psalm 118:22; Acts 4:11	The foundation stone of God’s building	The rejected stone becomes the essential foundation of salvation.	Rock, Foundation
Foundation	1 Corinthians 3:11	The only base on which the Church is built	No spiritual structure stands unless built on Him.	Cornerstone, Rock
Resurrection and the Life	John 11:25	The source of eternal life beyond death	He doesn’t only <i>give</i> resurrection—He <i>is</i> resurrection.	Life, Firstborn from the Dead
